RULES & REGULATIONS

There have been no modifications to the 2010 Renegade Bass' rules and regulations which are now adopted for the 2011 season. Anglers are responsible to know the rules, so make sure you review them. Any rule questions or interpretations must be brought to the attention of the Tournament Director Greg Scott.

PRE-TOURNAMENT MEETING

At 6:45 a.m., all teams will turn off their main engines while instructions and weigh in procedures will be given over the PA system.

STARTING PROCEDURES

Each team will take their boat to the designated **boat check area** where the boat will be checked and recorded by the shore crew. **All** boats must be checked before they can fish in the tournament. It will be a trickle start by team number. You must wait until your number is called before you leave or begin fishing. Start time is 7:00 a.m.

IMPORTANT NOTICE

It is very important to keep in mind that competitors use courtesy, consideration and respect when fishing docks, boats or in close proximity to cottages. If people are swimming or sitting on the docks do not flip or cast near the docks. Keep a safe distance away and respect the property owners. If possible try striking up a friendly conversation with them, use your judgment on whether they are comfortable with you being close by. If the property owner becomes upset, take the high road, apologize and leave the area immediately. We want to be welcomed back to the lakes and rivers we fish. Renegade Bass maintains excellent relationships with a number of cottage associations; we do not want to jeopardize them.

Safe return of all teams competing in the tournament is the top priority of the association. Getting your fish to the weigh-in on time is exclusively the angler's responsibility.

TOURNAMENT HOSTS

Our host for the St.Lawrence event is town of Morrisburg. We wish to thank them for allowing us to use their beautiful park and launch facilities. Please use the garbage cans provided to keep the premises clean.

COWLING MARKERS

Please try to keep your cowling markers for all events. They are expensive since we demand a premium adhesive that should not damage paint for up to 4 months.





IMPORTANT NOTICE

Competitors MUST stop and help any vessel under distress that is the Law! If another competitor is flagging you down please stop and aid them. If you are running in for weigh-in you can stop get their location or take one of them with their fish and bring them back to the weigh-in. Then make tournament staff aware of their location so the vessel in distress can be retrieved.

WEIGH-IN PROCEDURES

Weigh-in is at 4:00 p.m. Late penalties apply as per rules. The block order for the St. Lawrence event is **A-B-C-D-E**. When weighing in, you must come into the designated weigh-in area and check in with the Shore Staff. If you have any problems, look for a member of the shore crew to direct you. One member of the team will drop the other member on shore to weigh in fish and pick up the trailer, and then move away from the dock area. Shore staff will help with the directions at the weigh-in area and pass out weigh-in bags.

It is imperative to follow ALL DIRECTIONS given by shore staff and the Tournament Director. We need everyone's patience here.

MISSISSIPPI LAKE PRO-AM EVENT

This past Sunday, Renegade held the Pro-Am event on Mississippi Lake in Carleton Place. A field of 30 amateurs were paired with members who volunteered their day and services to introduce these amateurs to the sport of tournament bass fishing. Renegade Bass would like to thank all these members, as well as those that showed up to help with the event. Taking top honours in the event was the team of Rob Jackson and Chris Coker with an impressive weight of 19.00 lbs anchored by a 6.30 lb largemouth.

RADIO SHOW

RANGER CUP

The Ranger Cup program will reward \$500 to the top placing Ranger owner registered for Ranger Cup. When powered by an Evinrude, the owner will receive a \$500 certificate for Evinrude products at Orleans Boat World and Sport. Orleans Boat World and Sport will add an additional \$250 if the Ranger was purchased at Orleans Boat World and Sport.

BIG FISH PRIZES

There will be prizes for the 3 largest fish in each tournament. All fish must be alive to be eligible. In addition to the **Renegade Bass Big Fish** award of \$350 the **optional** supplementary pool of \$20 per team will be split 50/30/20 % for the 3 largest fish for teams participating in the pool. As introduced in 2009, a team can weigh-in multiple big fish. See rules for full details.

G. LOOMIS SKELETON CREW CHALLENGE

Participating teams must have purchases a G.Loomis rod before June 26, 2011 to be eligible. Qualifying teams who weigh-in the biggest bass of the tournament win an additional \$500 from G.Loomis.

SHIMANO PLATINUM CUP

Teams purchasing eligible Shimano products before June 26, 2011 accumulate points throughout the 5 qualifiers events where the team with the most points wins their 2012 entries fee paid from by Shimano Canada and a \$250 gas card.
